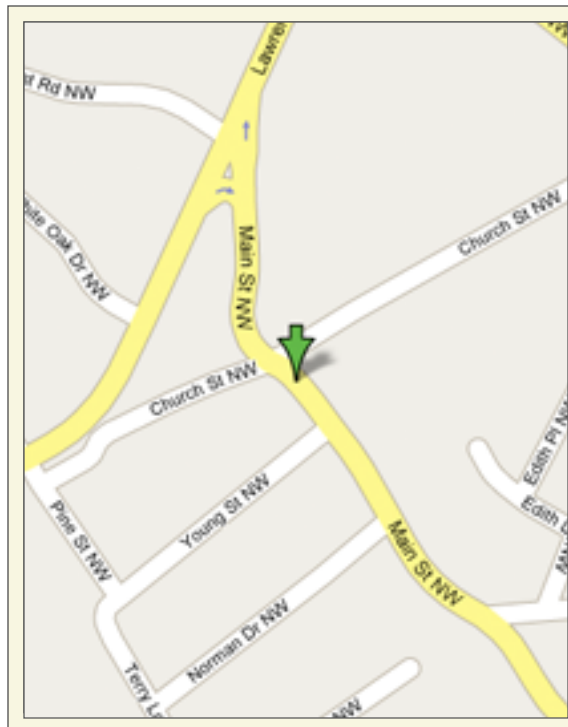

# 2008 Conference Schedule

## Conference Format

There will be 12 speaking sessions in the conference. Each afternoon there will be 3 "breakout" sessions from which to choose. Every morning will begin with a "concert of prayer" where there will be 1 hour of earnest pleading prayer to God for a genuine revival. Speakers and attendees will be asked to participate in this process.

Childcare will be provided for all main speaking sessions indicated by the bolded numbers on the right hand side of this page. Attendees will be responsible for their own accommodations and all other amenities including food.

## Prayer Room

There will be a prayer room indicated clearly by signs for every day of the conference. It will stay open allowing people to participate for short durations or longer durations of time. It is recommended that all attendees spend at least 20 minutes in the prayer room each day. Emphasis will be put on this part of the event for all attendees to participate in this vital and necessary element of the conference.

## Sanctuary

During the entire event the main sanctuary is to be considered a place where people are to meet with God through worship, prayer and preaching. It is asked that you come quietly into the sanctuary and do not converse excessively or loudly once seated. Social interactions and fellowship should primarily be done in the foyers and halls.
