God has prepared it for them for the time of the flood. How can we have this love for God and our neighbor? God will give it to us if we ask Him. Now is the time of preparation.

Now, before the terrible catastrophes break out and the powers of seduction devour the earth. That is, we must pray for love and pray for God to show us where we are unloving, which areas of our lives need to be changed. When we yield ourselves to Him to be prepared and purified, then He will transform us into His own image, which is infinite, pure, and eternal love.
