The sermon emphasizes the importance of acting on what we hear, building a strong foundation on rock, and trusting in Christ as the only access to God.

Scripture: Luke 6:47

Topics: "Faith in Action", "Foundation in Christ"

Description

Chuck Smith emphasizes the distinction between two types of hearers in relation to Christ's teachings: those who act on His words and those who do not. He asserts that Jesus claimed to be the only begotten Son of God and the sole access to salvation, highlighting the necessity of faith in Him for eternal life. Smith illustrates the importance of building a strong foundation in Christ, likening it to a house built on rock that withstands life's storms, while those who hear but fail to act are left with no foundation and face ruin. The sermon calls for a response to Christ's claims and encourages believers to dig deep in their faith.

1. "Nothing to stand on."

B. Fall immediately.

1. Don't change.

2. Don't repent.
