It is a word or expression in which a person is represented to us. When I mention, or hear a name, it brings to mind the whole man, what I know of him, and also the impression he has made on me. The name of a king includes his honor, his power, and his kingdom. His name is the symbol of his power." The person who believes in the name of Jesus doesn't have to fear anything in this world. The Lord Jesus said that whatever we ask in His name will be given to us. The name of Jesus Christ represents all His acts, not only that He is our mediator in heaven.

The overall work and power of Jesus is represented by his name. Christ is completely human and completely God. To reveal Himself in this earth, the Lord chose the name Jesus Christ.
