Proverbs talks about the fear of the Lord as the beginning of wisdom. It's the fountain of life. By the fear of the Lord, we depart from evil, we depart from sin.

And I think a healthy, biblical fear of the Lord is essential. And if we are not, as individuals and as churches, living in the healthy, biblical fear of the Lord, then there's something fundamentally wrong in our relationship with Him.
