Description

In this sermon, the preacher emphasizes the importance of taking God's word seriously and living out the visions He gives us. The example of Abraham is used to illustrate this point. Abraham obeyed God's vision and left his old life behind, embarking on a new heavenly vocation. The sermon also highlights the challenges Abraham faced, such as encountering trials and battles, but ultimately God remained faithful to His promise and protected Abraham.

Transcript

Let's turn to Proverbs chapter twenty-nine, verse eighteen, the first phrase. Where there is no vision, the people cast off restraint. We'll read from verse nine.

By faith he dwelt in a land of promise, as in a foreign country. By faith, Sarah herself also received strength to conceive seed, and she bore a child when she was past the age, because she judged him faithful who had promised. Therefore, from one man, and him as good as dead, were born as many as the stars of the sky in multitude, innumerable as the sand which is by the seashore.

These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, were sure of them, embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on earth. For those who say such things, declare plainly that they seek a homeland. And truly, if they had called to mind that country from which they had come out, they would have had opportunity to return.

But now they desire a better, that is, heavenly country, therefore God is not ashamed to be called their God, for He has prepared a city for them. Let's have a further word of prayer. Lord, we thank you, we praise you, you are the one who speaks.

We do pray that we have the right attitude toward your word. And we stand in fear and trembling before your word. And because of your word, we find true rest.

We thank you, your word is alive. Your life is operative.
